- 6 You made him ruler over the works of your hands; you put everything under his feet:
7 all flocks and herds, and the beasts of the field,
8 the birds of the air, and the fish of the sea, all that swim the paths of the seas.
- 9 O LORD, our Lord, how majestic is your name in all the earth!

Matthew 5:11-16

- 10 Blessed are those who are persecuted because of righteousness, for theirs is the kingdom
of heaven.
- 11 Blessed are you when people insult you, persecute you and
falsely say all kinds of evil against you because of me.
- 12 Rejoice and be glad, because great is your reward in heaven, for in the same
way they persecuted the prophets who were before you.
- 13 You are the salt of the earth. But if the salt loses its saltiness, how can it be made salty
again? It is no longer good for anything, except to be thrown out and trampled by men.
- 14 You are the light of the world. A city on a hill cannot be hidden.
- 15 Neither do people light a lamp and put it under a bowl.
Instead they put it on its stand, and it gives light to everyone in the house.
- 16 In the same way, let your light shine before men, that they may see your good deeds
and praise your Father in heaven.

- 1 In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God.
- 2 He was with God in the beginning.
- 3 Through him all things were made; without him nothing was made that has been made.
- 12 Yet to all who received him, to those who believed in his name,
he gave the right to become children of God.
- 14 The Word became flesh and made his dwelling among us. We have seen his glory,
the glory of the One and Only, who came from the Father, full of grace and truth.

Ephesians 6:10-18

- 10** Finally, be strong in the Lord and in his mighty power.
- 11** Put on the full armor of God so that you can take your stand against the devil's schemes.
- 12** For our struggle is not against flesh and blood, but against the rulers, against the authorities, against the powers of this dark world and against the spiritual forces of evil in the heavenly realms.
- 13** Therefore put on the full armor of God, so that when the day of evil comes, you may be able to stand your ground, and after you have done everything to stand.
- 14** Stand firm then, with the belt of truth buckled around your waist, with the breastplate of righteousness in place,
- 15** and with your feet fitted with the readiness that comes from the gospel of peace.
- 16** In addition to all this, take up the shield of faith, with which you can extinguish all the flaming arrows of the evil one.
- 17** Take the helmet of salvation and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God.
- 18** And pray in the Spirit on all occasions with all kinds of prayers and requests. With this in mind, be alert and always keep on praying for all the saints.

Hebrews 11:1-3

- 1** Now faith is being sure of what we hope for and certain of what we do not see.
- 2** This is what the ancients were commended for.
- 3** By faith we understand that the universe was formed at God's command, so that what is seen was not made out of what was visible.

Grade 6

Joshua 24:15b

But as for me and my household, we will serve the LORD.

Psalm 1

- 1 Blessed is the man who does not walk in the counsel of the wicked or stand in the way of sinners or sit in the seat of mockers.
- 2 But his delight is in the law of the LORD, and on his law he meditates day and night.
- 3 He is like a tree planted by streams of water, which yields its fruit in season and whose leaf does not wither. Whatever he does prospers.
- 4 Not so the wicked! They are like chaff that the wind blows away.
- 5 Therefore the wicked will not stand in the judgment, nor sinners in the assembly of the righteous.
- 6 For the Lord watches over the way of the righteous, but the way of the wicked will perish.

Psalm 91:1-6

- 1 He who dwells in the shelter of the Most High will rest in the shadow of the Almighty.
- 2 I will say of the LORD, "He is my refuge and my fortress, my God, in whom I trust."
- 3 Surely he will save you from the fowler's snare and from the deadly pestilence.
- 4 He will cover you with his feathers, and under his wings you will find refuge; his faithfulness will be your shield and rampart.
- 5 You will not fear the terror of night, nor the arrow that flies by day,
- 6 nor the pestilence that stalks in the darkness, nor the plague that destroys at midday.

Psalm 139:1-10

- 1 O LORD, you have searched me and you know me.
- 2 You know me when I sit and when I rise; you perceive my thoughts from afar.
- 3 You discern my going out and my lying down; you are familiar with all my ways.
- 4 Before a word is on my tongue you know it completely, O LORD.
- 5 You hem me in – behind and before; you have laid your hand upon me.
- 6 Such knowledge is too wonderful for me, too lofty for me to attain.
- 7 Where can I go from your Spirit? Where can I flee from your presence?
- 8 If I go up to the heavens, you are there; if I make my bed in the depths, you are there.
- 9 If I rise on the wings of the dawn, if I settle on the far side of the sea,
- 10 even there your hand will guide me, your right hand will hold me fast.

Matthew 16:24-25

- 24 Then Jesus said to his disciples, "If anyone would come after me, he must deny himself and take up his cross and follow me.
- 25 For whoever wants to save his life will lose it, but whoever loses his life for me will find it.

Colossians 3:12-15

- 12** Therefore, as God's chosen people, holy and dearly loved, clothe yourselves with compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness and patience.

and his understanding no one can fathom.
29 he gives strength to the weary and increases the power of the weak.
30 Even youths grow tired and weary, and young men stumble and fall;
31 but those who hope in the LORD will renew their strength. They will soar on wings like
eagles; they will run and not grow weary; they will walk and not be faint.

Grade 8

John 14:6

Jesus answered: "I am the way and the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me.

John 15:5-8

- 5 I am the vine; you are the branches. If a man remains in me and I in him, he will bear much fruit; apart from me you can do nothing.
- 6 If anyone does not remain in me, he is like a branch that is thrown away and withers; such branches are picked up, thrown into the fire and burned.
- 7 If you remain in me and my words remain in you, ask whatever you wish, and it will be given you.
- 8 This is to my Father's glory, that you bear much fruit, showing yourselves to be my disciples.

I Corinthians 13:4-8a

- 4 Love is patient, love is kind. It does not envy, it does not boast, it is not proud.
- 5 It is not rude, it is not self-seeking, it is not easily angered, it keeps no record of wrongs.
- 6 Love does not delight in evil but rejoices with the truth.
- 7 It always protects, always trusts, always hopes, always perseveres.
- 8 Love never fails.

Galatians 5:22, 23

- 22 But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness,
- 23 gentleness and self-control. Against such things there is no law.

Philippians 2:5-11

- 5 Your attitude should be the same as that of Christ Jesus:
- 6 Who, being in very nature God, did not consider equality with God something to be grasped,
- 7 but made himself nothing, taking the very nature of a servant, being made in human likeness.
- 8 And being found in appearance as a man, he humbled himself and became obedient to death – even death on a cross!
- 9 Therefore God exalted him to the highest place and gave the name that is above every name.
- 10 that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, in heaven and on earth and under the earth.
- 11 and every tongue confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.

Hebrews 11:6
