1. Physical appearance. What does the character look like? Are they young or old? Picture the character in your mind and then describe them.

2. Attitude. Describe how the character acts. How do they treat other people? What do they think of themselves?

3. Round flat character. Why? How do they change/ not change?

Setting:

Physical: Where the story takes place:

- Which country
- Rural/urban setting
- Indoor/outdoor

Temporal:

- Which historical period
- What season
- What time of day

Emotional setting: called atmosphere (the mood of the story)

Plot: (events)

Exposition: this sets the stage for what is to come

Problem: What needs to be solved through the book?

Rising action...8 – 10 major events that happen through the story

Climax: when the problem is the greatest, or gets resolved. This is usually the most exciting part of the story.

Falling action: after the climax, the events that brings the reader to the end of the book

Resolution: how the story ends.

Did you like the book? **Why or why not?**

Would you recommend the book to other people to read? **Why or why not?** Would everyone like the book or just some people?
